Snowmobile Regulations

Snowmobiles are not allowed on Cherry Street from the railroad tracks to North Public Road except to cross the Cherry Street bridge and can only be operated in town between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

Snow Season

Please remember when we have a large amount of snowfall in Shell Rock, the Mayor, Police Chief or the Public Works Director can declare a snow emergency. Snow emergencies for Shell Rock are announced on KWAY Radio and on KWWL Channel 7 television. When a snow emergency is declared no person shall park or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley or city owned off-street parking, unless the snow has been removed or plowed from the street and the snow has ceased to fall. Sidewalks must be shoveled and kept free from ice and snow.

From November 1st to March 31st there is no parking on Cherry St., from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. If you are parked there during this time you may be ticketed and towed.
