## Proposed Garbage & Sewer Rate Increase

Tues., May 6, 2008 the council will vote on the final reading on increasing the garbage and sewer rates. If passed these rates will be effective on July 1, 2008.

**Proposed Garbage Rates:**

35 gallon container: \$15.65

64 gallon container: \$21.75

96 gallon container: \$28.30

**Proposed Sewer Increase Rates:**

- **Residential Property** - The charge for each residential property shall be an amount equal to \$5.00 plus 95% of the water service charge for the property; for the same period; provided, however, the minimum charge shall be \$10.25 for each such period; or, in the event the premises is without a water meter, the minimum monthly charge shall be \$15.50
- **Heavy Commercial Property** - The charge for each heavy commercial property shall be an amount equal to \$5.00 plus 115% of the water service charge for the property for the same period. The minimum charge shall be \$20.75 for each such period.
- **School Property** - The charge for each school property shall be \$47.00 for each monthly bill period or fraction thereof.
- **County Property** - The charge for each County property shall be \$11.30 for each monthly billing period or fraction thereof.

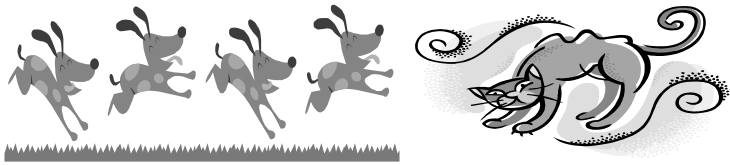

## Riverside Cemetery Policy

1. Flowers & decorations are allowed only if they are placed at the ends of the monuments on the cemetery foundations and they do not extend over the edges where they interfere with the mowing. They may be hung on the monument or put in stands set into/against the cement foundations. If they are placed anywhere else, they will be removed, tagged and placed in the shed for pick-up.
2. Artificial wreaths are allowed provided they are attached to the monument or mounted on a rod placed in/against the foundation. Limit rods to one please!
3. No plantings allowed-this includes, trees, shrubs or perennial flowers. No extra concrete pads other than tombstone pads.
4. If you use wires, make sure you do not leave in ground.



Regulations 1 and 2 do not apply during May 15–June 16, when decorations are allowed to be displayed in the grass for Memorial Day. Please save the time and cost of caring for our cemetery by removing your items by June 15th. This becomes a large project for the caretakers. Thank You!
