Please remember that with the coming of cooler weather comes the chance of snow. When Shell Rock gets enough snow, the Mayor, Police Chief and The Public Works Director can declare a snow emergency. Snow emergencies for Shell Rock are announced on KWAY radio and KWWL Channel 7 on television. In the event a snow emergency is declared no person shall park or leave unattended vehicles on any public street, alley or City owned off-street parking area unless the snow has been removed or plowed from the street and the snow has ceased to fall.
