Mayor Mike Klinefelter called November 4, 2025, regular session of the Shell Rock City Council to order at 7:00 pm in the Council Chambers at 802 N Public Road, Shell Rock, Iowa with the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilors present Garrett Schuldt, Adam Fox, Jared Krull, Mark Berglund, and David Beenen by phone. Eight people were in the audience along with Mike Tellinghuisen and Jessica Meyer.

Motion by Schuldt seconded by Fox to approve the agenda. Ayes- Fox, Schuldt, Beenen, Krull, Berglund. Nays-None. Motion carried 5:0.

Motion by Fox seconded by Beenen to approve the consent agenda that included: Minutes 10/07/2025 & 10/21/2025, the Payment of Bills, Street Finance Report. Roll Call Vote: Ayes- Fox, Schuldt, Beenen, Krull, Berglund. Nays-None. Motion carried 5:0.

Mike Tellinghuisen reported that the Boyd Building phase 1 kitchen remodel is nearly finished. Cupboards, countertops, sinks, and hardware are installed. Volunteers will be organizing dishes and kitchen supplies shortly. Thank you to all who have helped with this project. Phase 2 of the kitchen remodel is being discussed.

Matt Mohn, Fire Chief reported that over \$7,000 was raised during their pancake breakfast. Thank you to all that donated and attended. The Fire Department uses raised funds to purchase items such as the battery powered jaws of life. Mike Tellinghuisen, Public Works Director reported that park bathrooms are closed for the winter season, plans are being made for holiday lights and decorating, and snow removal equipment is prepped.

Discussion held concerning funds transfer from the General Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund. This item tabled until budget meetings.

Mayor Klinefelter appointed Claire Epley to the Library Board of Trustees. This fills a vacant position with a term expiring 06/30/2027. Council approved 5:0.

Motion Berglund seconded by Fox to approve Boyd Building rental fee waiver for Super Bowl Brunch Fundraiser. Ayes- Fox, Schuldt, Beenen, Krull, Berglund. Nays-None. Motion carried 5:0.
