

Special Meeting Shell Rock City Council
January 16, 2023

Mayor Larry Young called the special meeting to order in the City Hall at 6:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Council Members Donald Bonzer, Robyn Holden, Michael Klinefelter, Jared Krull, and Garrett Schuldt were present. There were four people in the audience.

Motion by Schuldt seconded by Krull to approve the agenda with any additions. Ayes-Bonzer, Holden, Klinefelter, Krull, and Schuldt. Nays-None. Motion carried.

Motion by Schuldt seconded by Klinefelter to approve the amendment for the change in corporate officer for Kwik Trip Inc., Kwik Star Store 705. Ayes-Bonzer, Holden, Klinefelter, Krull, and Schuldt. Nays-None. Motion carried.

Resolution 003-2023 was introduced by Bonzer seconded by Krull: A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASING AGREEMENT FOR REAL ESTATE. The agreement is for the City of Shell Rock to purchase parcels #12-11-261-016 and #12-11-276-005 located in the City of Shell Rock - from Adam Neal in the amount of \$3,000.00. Roll Call Vote: Ayes-Bonzer, Holden, Klinefelter, Krull, and Schuldt. Nays-None. Motion carried.

Budget requests for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 were presented by the Community Protection Departments, Home and Community Environment Departments, and some of the Culture and Recreation Departments. The council also listened to a presentation from the Riverside Cemetery Association John Holden asking for monetary support from the city for the Riverside Cemetery Association.
