July 2 from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m.

July 3 from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m.

July 4 from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m.

If there is a burn ban—No Fireworks Allowed

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Before you make any improvements, additions, or structural changes to the outside of your house, building, or property, please check with City Hall to see if you need a building/zoning/fence permit.

Garbage lids have to completely closed or the garbage will not be picked up. Recycling cans do not have to be closed, they can be up and glass containers do not have to be put in a separate container.

Don't burn leaves or yard waste near the asphalt streets.

All of the city parks close at 10 p.m. There are no motorized vehicles allowed in the grassy areas of the city parks.

Vehicles need to be licensed and operable if sitting outside on your property. Vehicles parked on the city right of way must be moved every forty-eight (48) hours.

If you have not purchased your sticker for your golf cart for 2022, please do so. Persons driving golf carts, must have a regular driver's license issued by the Iowa Department of Transportation and must be 16 years of age.
