IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Before you make any improvements, additions, or structural changes to the outside of your house, building, or property, please check with City Hall to see if you need a building/zoning/fence permit.

Don't burn leaves or yard waste near the asphalt streets.

All of the city parks close at 10 p.m. There are no motorized vehicles allowed in the grassy areas of the city parks.

Vehicles need to be licensed and operable if sitting outside on your property. Vehicles parked on the city right of way must be moved every forty-eight (48) hours.

If you have not purchased your sticker for your golf cart for 2022, please do so.

Garbage lids have to be completely closed or the garbage will not be picked up.
Recycling cans do not have to be closed and GLASS CONTAINERS MAY NOW BE PUT IN WITH THE REST OF THE RECYCLING.

The automatic payment plan allows your utility bill to be paid directly from your bank account on the due date of the bill every month at no cost, regardless of where you bank! Your bill will state when the payment begins.
