



The community would like to honor our outgoing mayor, Larry Young, and outgoing council members, Don Bonzer, Mike Klinefelter, and Robyn Holden with an Open House on December 29, 2023 from 2-4 PM at City Hall. Mayor Young has been one of the longest serving mayors of this community with a 22 year span. The community has seen many positive changes during that time period:

- Increase in valuation by over \$20 million, almost doubling the amount from when he started serving the city
- Cherry Street Bridge Renovation
- New City Hall and Maintenance Building
- Emergency Services Building
- McCague Park Improvements
- Holley Park

In addition to his contributions to Shell Rock, Larry served on the board of directors at Iowa Northland Regional Council of Governments (INRCOG) since 2002. He also served as a member of the Shell Rock Development Corporation for many years and was the Master of Ceremony for the Swing Show for over 50 years.
