TREE TRIMMING REMINDER The city code requires that tree branches over sidewalks and streets/parking be kept above a certain height. Please trim branches over sidewalks to no less than 8 feet and branches over streets/parking to no less than 18 feet.

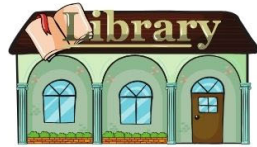
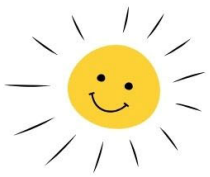
