

GARBAGE AND RECYCLE INFORMATION

Weekly trash collection will be on Wednesday. Green trash lids must be completely closed for pickup.

Additional stickers for extra bags are sold at City Hall. All extra bags must be tied shut with stickers around the top of the bag. Bags shall be thirty-three (33) gallons or less in size. Bags shall weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds each. Cost is \$1.75 per sticker.

Recycle will be every other Wednesday.

The container will be a 64-gallon blue tote. All recycling must be clean and dry. Do not put material in plastic bags.

Acceptable Recycling Materials:

Cardboard: clean and flattened

Paper: newspapers, junk mail, magazines, mixed office paper, computer paper, paperback books, phone books, paper bags,

Empty Aerosol Cans

Metal cans (labels can still be on), Pots, Pans, Loose Aluminum Foil

Clear Glass with lids removed

Plastic # 1,2 3,4,5,6,7 (Look for the recycling arrows and number on the container),

****All lids must be removed. Lids four inches in diameter or smaller are trash. Lids larger than four inches in diameter can be recycled.**

NOT Acceptable Recycling Materials:

Styrofoam of any kind (Plastic #6), any dirty or contaminated recyclable material, trash,

Wax or plastic coated cardboard such as milk or juice cartons or butter boxes,

Wax paper, carbon paper, Photo's, Tissues, Napkins, Paper Towels, Paper Plates,

Hard Cover Book Covers, Crayon Drawings, Smoking Materials, Any Plastic Bags,

Mirrors, Ceramics, Ovenware, Dishes, Cups, Clay Pots, Crystal, Window Glass,

Plate Glass, Light Bulbs, Medicine Bottles, Container Lids under four inches,

Unmarked Plastic (No recycling arrows or number), Foil Lined Fiber Cans,

Stretch Wrap, Plastic Packaging Wrap, Wrapping Paper, Film, Green & Brown Glass,

Oil (Cooking & Motor & Hydraulic) Containers, Anti-Freezer Containers,

Needles, Syringes, Bullets, Shotgun Shells, Other Hazardous Material
