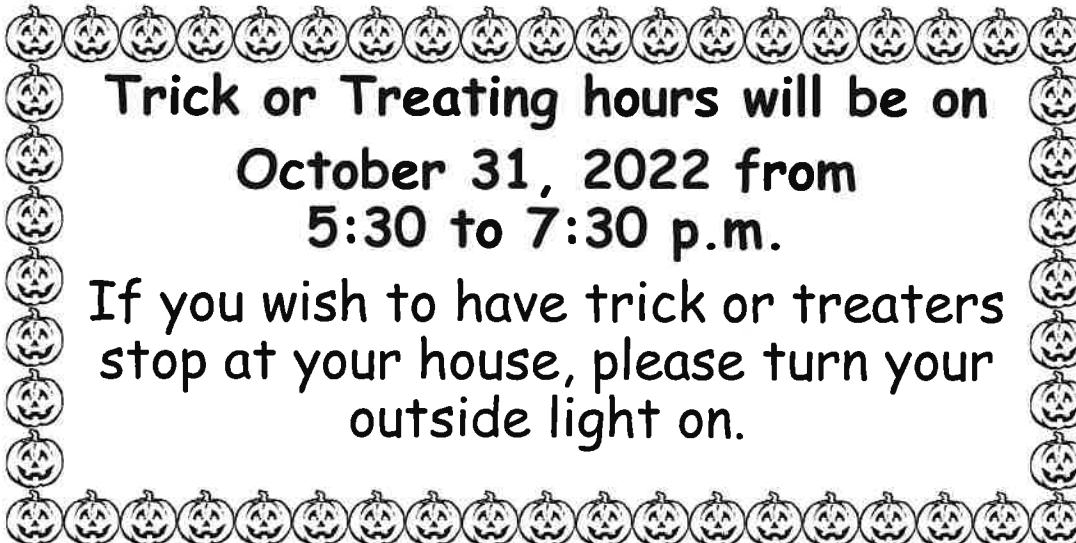

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Before you make any improvements, additions, or structural changes to the outside of your house, building, or property, please check with City Hall to see if you need a building/zoning/fence permit.

Garbage lids have to be completely closed or the garbage will not be picked up. Recycling cans do not have to be closed, they can be up and glass containers do not have to be put in a separate container.

Don't burn leaves or yard waste near the asphalt streets.

All of the city parks close at 10 p.m. There are no motorized vehicles allowed in the grassy areas of the city parks. No motorized vehicles including (ATV's, UTV's or golf carts, motorcycles, or motor bikes) are allowed on the paved trail in the Jeffrey Rasmussen Park.

Vehicles need to be licensed and operable if sitting outside on your property. Vehicles parked on the city right of way must be moved every forty-eight (48) hours.



Tree Trimming Reminder

Time to Check Your Trees!

The Shell Rock City Code requires that property owners with trees on their property or in the parking that abuts their property must keep the trees pruned to provide a minimum clearance over the sidewalk, the parking, and the street. Section 151.09 of the City Code provides that "The minimum clearance of any overhanging portion thereof shall be 8 feet over sidewalks for trees on private property, and 18 feet over all streets and parking and sidewalks on parking.

You may take branches from trees that are trimmed to the City's yard waste site located at the waste water treatment plant. The City does not chip or haul branches as a free service, unless it is fewer than 12 bundles that are no more than 10 inches in diameter, bundled with string or twine, or twelve single limbs set cut side edge to the road on the street side.
