RULES AND REGULATIONS

of the

RIVERSIDE CEMETERY

- No burial, casket or cremains, shall be permitted without approval from the Cemetery Board.
- No fences, railings, curbing, bark mulch or rock on or around gravesites.
- Flowers or other decorations should be removed when their appearance has deteriorated.
- The planting of trees, shrubs, or flowers is not permitted.
- No disrespect or desecration of grave sites.
- All pets must be on leashes.
- Walking, jogging, bicycling welcome.
- Cemetery closed at sunset to sunrise.
- All persons visiting the cemetery should be quiet and show reverence. Vagrancy, picnicking, alcohol and drug use, fires, unnecessary noise, loud behavior, trespassing and other objectionable activity are never permitted.
- Winter decorations need to be removed by April 1.
- All decorations should be contained within the headstone's concrete pad. Decorations are allowed on the grass the weekend before and after Memorial Day to accommodate the holiday displays. Please remove them by the Sunday following Memorial Day.
- Please personally remove your decorations and do not throw any in the wooded areas.
