MAYOR'S CORNER: E-BIKE RIDERS AND PARENTS PLEASE READ THIS With mounting complaints and concerns about e-bikes this summer the Mayor and City Council have agreed that all e-bikes must follow the bicycle ordinances of Shell Rock. **NO E-BIKES MAY RIDE ON SIDEWALKS IN THE BUSINESS DISTRICT OF CHERRY STREET.** E-bike riders are to yield the right of way to any pedestrian and shall give audible signal before overtaking and passing. E-bikes are required to stop at all stops signs in town. We have all seen these things not happening on a regular basis. The County Sheriff Officers are being advised to this and the penalty for violation is the impoundment of the e-bike for 5 days for 1st offense, 10 days for 2nd offense, and 30 days for 3rd offense. — Mayor Klinefelter
