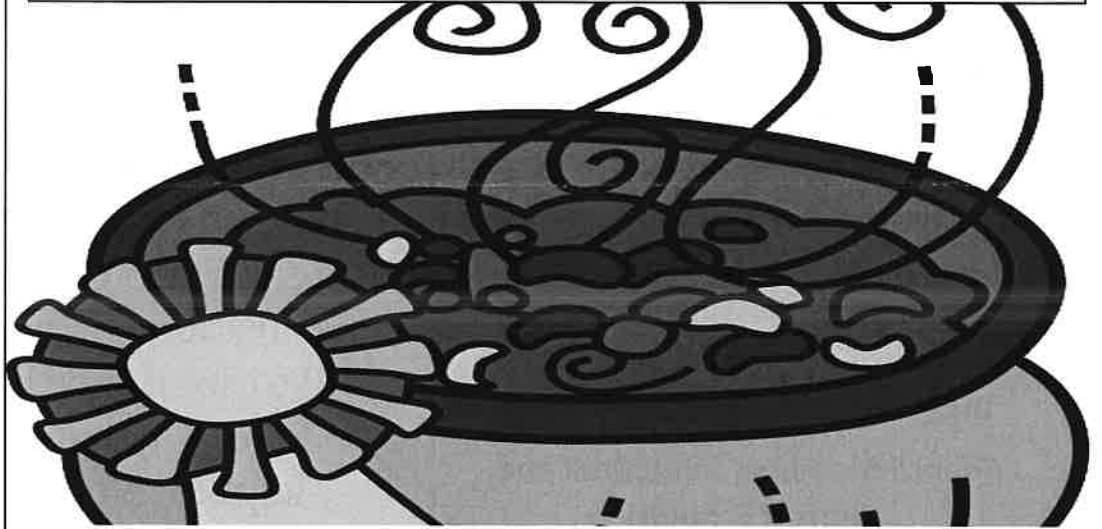

City Election Results

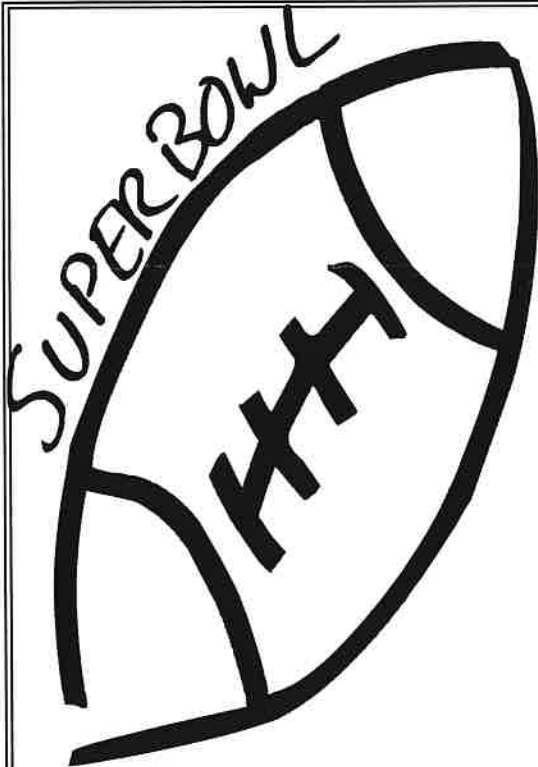
There was a city election held on November 2, 2021 and the results were as follows:
