Shell Rock Aquatics is now hiring lifeguards for the 2022 season!

Assistant Manager-must 15 years old. Head Lifeguard-must be 15 years old, Concessions-must be 15 years old, Lifeguard-must be 15 years old, Swimming Instructor-must be 15 years old. Job descriptions can be found at www.shellrockiowa.org/aquatic-center.

Training is available at the W in Waverly on April 8-10 and May 13-15. Participants must be at least 15 years of age before the end of the course to enroll. Lifeguard/First Aid & CPR/AED certifications are valid for 2 years. Participants must attend all class sessions in order to obtain certifications.
