Spring Clean Up

- Charges will be the same rates as the Butler County Transfer Station
- Anyone who has items to be picked up must pay the fees and sign their name and articles to be picked up. They will be issued a sticker to be put on articles.
- The city crew will try to pick up the articles as soon as possible and dispose of them at the county transfer station. This will hopefully keep other people from removing the items from other households and hauling them around town.
- If you have an item to be picked up by someone other than the city, the disposal fee will not be refunded.
- There will be NO removal of demolition materials.
- Items should be out to the street no later than Wednesday, April 24, 2024.
